State House Map

Amendment 1 (H000H9049) to HJR 6011 (H000H9027) by Vice Chair Precourt

- Makes the municipality of Indian Shores (Pinellas County) whole.
- Makes the municipalities of Palm Bay and Melbourne Beach (Brevard County) whole.
- Makes the municipalities of Medley and Sweetwater (Miami-Dade County) whole.
- Makes the unincorporated Census Designated Place of Estero (Lee County) whole and corresponding changes that are necessary to accomplish this.
- Makes the municipalities of Lake Alfred, Auburndale, Haines City and Frostproof (Polk County) whole.
- Makes changes to Duval County districts 11-16 to better align districts with the St. Johns River.
- Makes the unincorporated Census Designated Place The Acreage (Palm Beach County) whole.
- Adjusts the boundaries between Districts 18 and 19 pursuant to the request of the Clay County Supervisor of Elections.
- Adjusts the boundaries between Districts 8 and 9 pursuant to the request of the Leon County Supervisor of Elections.
- Adjusts the boundaries between Districts 1 and 2 pursuant to the request of the Escambia County Supervisor of Elections.
- Overall, reduces the number of municipalities split to 75 (of 411). Florida's current State House map, as adopted in 2002, splits 170 municipalities.

State House Map

Amendment 2 (SPUBH0177) to HJR 6011 (H000H9027) by Chair Weatherford

- A map submitted by the League of Women Voters of Florida, the National Council of La Raza and Common Cause of Florida.

Congressional Map

Amendment 1 (H000C9047) to HB 6005 (H000C9043) by Vice Chair Precourt

- Makes the municipalities of Tarpon Springs, Oldsmar and Gulfport (Pinellas County) whole.
- Makes the municipalities of Coconut Creek, Hallandale Beach, Hollywood and Wilton Manors (Broward County) whole.
- Makes the municipalities of Opa-locka, North Miami and North Miami Beach (Miami-Dade County) whole.
- Makes the municipalities of Loxahatchee Groves and Lake Park (Palm Beach County) whole.
- Makes the municipalities of Dundee and Auburndale (Polk County) whole.
- Makes Okeechobee County whole.
- Makes Osceola County whole.

- Increases the Black voting age population of District 5 to greater than 50% (exactly 50.06% Black VAP).
- Increases the Hispanic voting age population of District 9 to 41.39%.
- Increases the total minority voting age population of District 14 to 53.46%.
- District 15 shifts to encompass the municipality of Bartow.
- Overall, reduces the number of municipalities split to 27 (of 411). Florida's current Congressional map, as adopted in 2002, splits 110 municipalities.
- Overall, reduces the number of counties split to 21 (of 67). Florida's current Congressional map, as adopted in 2002, splits 30 counties.

Amendment 2 (SPUBC0170) to HB 6005 (H000C9043) by Chair Weatherford

- A map submitted by the League of Women Voters of Florida, the National Council of La Raza and Common Cause of Florida.

State Senate Map

Amendment 1 (S000S9008) to HJR 6001 (S000S9004) by Vice Chair Precourt

- Conforms HJR 9001 to the State Senate map in CS/SJR 1176 (S000S9008).
 - **Conforming has the effect of:** Overall, reduces the number of municipalities split to 54 (of 411). Florida's current State Senate map, as adopted in 2002, splits 126 municipalities.
 - **Conforming has the effect of:** Adjusts boundaries to multiple districts based on the requests of multiple county supervisors of election.
