RE: 2011 Interim – Redistricting Public Meetings

This memorandum outlines administrative and process information for this summer's joint House and Senate public meetings regarding redistricting. The public input from these meetings, input from submissions to the House's MyDistrictBuilder applications, and other forms of public participation will serve as the starting point for redistricting. Accordingly, all Members of the Florida House of Representatives are welcome and encouraged to attend the meetings.

For Members of the Redistricting Committee and Subcommittees:

Pursuant to my April 8, 2011 memorandum all members of the Redistricting Committee or subcommittees are required to attend 25% of this summer's public hearings, including meetings outside your region. As listed in the attachment to this memorandum, each Member of the Redistricting Committee and subcommittees is assigned to attend meetings in two regions of Florida: one region close to your current district, the other region further away from your district. In total, every Member of the Committee and its subcommittees will attend at least 7 meetings. Please consider these assignments as a minimum. You are welcome to attend any and all of the other meetings throughout the State.

If you have conflicts regarding the meetings to which you are assigned, you can trade a meeting or meetings with one of your colleagues on your respective committee or subcommittee. If you serve on both the Redistricting Committee and a subcommittee, you must switch your assignment with another Member of your subcommittee. The attached assignments are organized to ensure that the Redistricting Committee and each of its subcommittees are represented adequately at every meeting.

These public meetings will be noticed as joint meetings of the Redistricting Committee, the House Redistricting Subcommittee, the Senate Redistricting Subcommittee, and the Congressional Redistricting Subcommittee. Therefore, as Members of Redistricting Committee or its subcommittees, your travel will be reimbursed for both locations to which you are assigned and any additional locations you choose to attend.

For each location, you are responsible for making your own travel arrangements and accommodations. Two weeks prior to each week of meetings, House Administration will provide you with information related to options for travel accommodations and services, including hotels and transportation.

For Members Who Are NOT on the Redistricting Committee and Subcommittees:

You are welcome and encouraged to attend any of the public meetings throughout the State. You may reimburse your travel expenses through your Intradistrict Account, your Member Expense Account, or your Office Account. As a courtesy, the House Redistricting Committee will include you on communications regarding these meetings throughout the summer.

For All Members of the House:

Because your safety is a top priority as we make the necessary arrangements for these public meetings, we ask that you please notify the staff of the House Redistricting Committee (office at 850-488-3928 or cell at 850-443-8626) when you plan to attend a meeting. Likewise, if your plans change, please notify the staff of the House Redistricting Committee. Knowing which Members will be in attendance will allow us to incorporate the appropriate security measures in our planning.
